CLUB CONSTITUTION

A copy of the full Club Constitution and Rules is on display in the Clubhouse. You should take special note of the following sections:

4. Membership

No person may be admitted to membership of the Club or to any privileges of membership without an interval of at least two days between their application and the granting of their application for such membership. All new applications for membership must be submitted in writing to the Membership Secretary. The general committee may refuse any applicant for membership at their discretion or remove a member or members but only for good cause such as conduct or character likely to bring the Club or sport into disrepute.

18. Guests

Any member aged 18 and over shall be entitled to introduce guests to the Club provided that no person whose application for membership has been declined or who has been expelled from the Club shall be introduced as a guest. No member shall introduce more than two guests at any one time and then only a maximum of six times in any one year span. After that, such guests must then apply for membership.



DATA PROTECTION ACT

Within the meaning of the Data Protection Act, Braunton Cricket club is a 'not-for-profit organisation'. This means that we do not have to register our use of Personal data with the Information Commissioner, provided that we only use that data for the purposes of establishing or maintaining membership lists, or providing or administering activities for our members.

We will use the data you supply on this form for the following purposes:

Producing lists of members who have not paid their subscriptions

Sending information to members on matters directly relating to the the running of the club.
